SUBJ : RULE - TARGET SHOOTING PROHIBITED ON TOWN COMMUNITY LANDS "BROX"

DATE: AUGUST 28, 2017

At a meeting of the Milford Board of Selectmen held on August 28, 2017, the Board of Selectmen voted to adopt the rule regarding Target Shooting on Town Community Lands "BROX".

Target shooting on Town Community Lands "BROX" is prohibited.

No person shall target shoot with a firearm on the town owned property known as The Town Community Lands "BROX".

If a person is reported to be target shooting on posted town property they could receive a warning from the police. If the same person is reported to be target shooting a second time on the posted town property, they could receive a trespass notice, which notifies the individual that they are no longer allowed on the property. Should a third time occur, the person could be arrested and charged with Criminal Trespassing.

This rule is documented under the Municipal Code/Rule section of Town of Milford's web site www.milford.nh.gov, and any other place deemed necessary.

Signs that are approved by the Board of Selectmen will also be posted in the areas where the town has had reports of people target shooting and also main entry ways onto the Town Community Lands "BROX".
