Based upon review of the above referenced application, in accordance with RSA 482-A and RSA 485-A:17, a Wetlands Permit and Non-Site Specific Permit was issued. This permit shall not be considered valid unless signed as specified below.

**PERMIT DESCRIPTION:** Dredge approximately 11.5 acres of accumulated sediments from Osgood Pond, in four (4) phases, in order to restore the functions and values of a deep water habitat to the wetland system. The project will be entirely contained within the existing pond, without disturbance to the area of bordering wetland vegetation around the perimeter of the pond. The only area of disturbance to the shoreline/bank of the pond will be the access area used during construction, which will be converted to a boat launch ramp upon completion of the dredging. A 480 sq. ft. fishing pier will be installed and configured to accommodate access for youth and handicapped residents.

**THIS APPROVAL IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PROJECT SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:**


1. All work shall be in accordance with plans by Fieldstone Land Consultants, PLLC dated November 5, 2013, as received by the NH Department of Environmental Services (DES) on December 11, 2013.
2. Any further alteration of areas on this property that are within the jurisdiction of the DES Wetlands Bureau will require a new application and/or further permitting by the Bureau.
3. NH DES Wetlands Bureau Southeast Region staff and the Milford Conservation Commission shall be notified in writing prior to commencement of work and upon its completion.
4. Dredged material shall be placed outside of the jurisdiction of the DES Wetlands Bureau.
5. Appropriate siltation/erosion/turbidity controls shall be in place prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction, and remain in place until the area is stabilized. Silt fence(s) must be removed once the area is stabilized.
6. Work shall be done during drawdown.
7. Construction equipment shall be inspected daily for leaking fuel, oil and hydraulic fluid prior to entering surface waters or wetlands.

8. Faulty equipment shall be repaired prior to entering jurisdictional areas.
9. The contractor shall have appropriate oil spill kits on site and readily accessible at all times during construction and each operator shall be trained in its use.
10. All refueling of equipment shall occur outside of surface waters or wetlands.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS THAT APPLY TO ALL DES WETLANDS PERMITS:**

1. A copy of this permit shall be posted on site during construction in a prominent location visible to inspecting personnel;
2. This permit does not convey a property right, nor authorize any injury to property of others, nor invasion of rights of others;
3. The Wetlands Bureau shall be notified upon completion of work;
4. This permit does not relieve the applicant from the obligation to obtain other local, state or federal permits, and/or consult with other agencies as may be required (including US EPA, US Army Corps of Engineers, NH Department of Transportation, NH Division of Historical Resources (NH Department of Cultural Resources), NHDES-Alteration of Terrain, etc.);
5. Transfer of this permit to a new owner shall require notification to and approval by DES;
6. This permit shall not be extended beyond the current expiration date.
7. This project has been screened for potential impacts to **known** occurrences of rare species and exemplary natural communities in the immediate area. Since many areas have never been surveyed, or have received only cursory inventories, unidentified sensitive species or communities may be present. This permit does not absolve the permittee from due diligence in regard to state, local or federal laws regarding such communities or species.
